## What We Do

People to People works to help struggling Rocklanders through difficult times with dignity.

People to People is Rockland County's hunger relief organization that provides food and other services to **more than 4,000 Rocklanders every month.**

## Food Pantry

The People to People Food Pantry provides food to thousands of Rocklanders **every month** who struggle to put food on their tables.

Open five days a week and one evening, the **Food Pantry provides non-perishable items such as pasta, cereal, rice and canned goods as well as meat, poultry, dairy products as well as fresh fruits and vegetables.** Clients must meet eligibility requirements including Rockland County residency and income guidelines provided by Regional Food Bank of Northeastern New York.



## It's In The Bag!

It's In The Bag is a feeding program that provides children from low-income families participating in after-school programs at the Haverstraw Center and Nyack Center with **weekend food packages.**

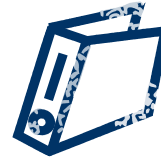


## Clothes Closet

Clients can browse the Dress Barn Clothes Closet while picking up their monthly food package. **Clients can take several gently-used clothing items per family member every month.**

## Back to School with Dignity

BTSWD is a vital PtoP program because **it provides essential school supplies to at-risk Rockland students** and makes it possible for these students to start the new school year on the road to success. Last year, BTSWD provided **backpacks filled with school supplies, including scientific calculators** for high school students, to **more than 2,000 children** from Rockland's struggling families.



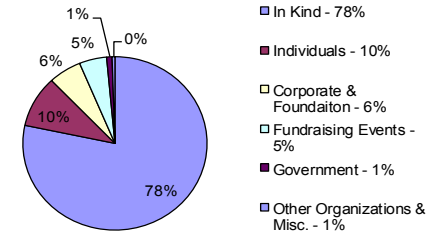
## Project Joy!

Project Joy! provides **generous donors with** the opportunity to **"adopt" a family** for the holidays, and **purchase presents from a child's Wish List.**

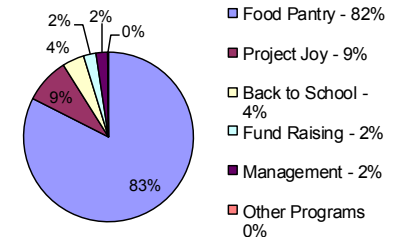
